Workshop on Training on Project Design, Proposal Writing, and Fundraising



The Institute of Cultural Affairs Nepal, in collaboration with Green Foundation Nepal, successfully concluded a 5-day intensive training program focused on essential topics such as proposal writing, project design, and fundraising from September (12 – 16) with expert guidance from professionals in these fields. During the training, participants engaged in deep discussions on how to secure support from international donor agencies, explore modern writing techniques and develop effective strategies for obtaining funding.

The sessions provided valuable knowledge, and participants praised the program for its practical impact, emphasizing the need for more opportunities like this in the future. The closing ceremony was attended by notable figures, including Bharti Pathak, a member of the Bagmati Province Assembly; Ghanshyam Pandey, President of Green Foundation; Professor Dr. Tatwa Prasad Timsina, a respected expert and trainer; and Ms. Ishu Subba, Executive Chair and co-facilitator of the program.





Their presence highlighted the importance of this training and its potential to strengthen the skills and accountability of professionals in the sector. The organizers are confident that the program will help develop capable and responsible individuals in proposal writing and fundraising. Held in the heart of Kathmandu, the event demonstrated both organizations' dedication to promoting excellence and innovation in these fields.








Awareness Raising Program on Plastic Pollution








Japan to Nepal Study Tour 2024

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
















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
